## What is Habitat for Humanity?

Columbus Area Habitat for Humanity, Inc. [CAHFH] is a non-profit Christian housing ministry which helps low-income families become homeowners through the unique Habitat for Humanity homeownership program.
The homeownership program works with families that meet the CAHFH three-fold criteria to find affordable mortgage solutions. Selected families will work with CAHFH to build or repair a home that the family will purchase with a no-interest, noprofit mortgage. Homeownership is affordable for low-income families because of the mortgage model used by Habitat. Oftentimes mortgage payments are significantly less than rent payments. Utilities are also more affordable because of the energy efficiency standards CAHFH strives for in home construction.

CAHFH requires potential homeowners to complete classes that include training in fiscal responsibility, home maintenance, and homeownership commitment.
